

CAMPUS SAFETY POLICY

The Fortuna Union High School District Board of Trustees believes that an orderly safe campus is absolutely essential to quality education.

In order to ensure a high level of District Campus Safety the Board hereby establishes a District Safety Committee whose job will be to monitor the safety conditions on all campuses and recommend to the Trustees policy changes.

1. The title of the Board appointed committee will be: the District Safety Committee.
2. The committee will be appointed each fall and the members will be approved by the Trustees. The term to serve on the committee will be: one (1) year.
3. The committee will meet four (4) times yearly.
4. The composition of the committee will be:
 - a. One (1) Board Member
 - b. Two (2) District Administrators (including the Vice Principal)
 - c. One (1) High School Counselor
 - d. One (1) Parent (selected by the Parents of the Student Body)
 - e. Two (2) Faculty Members (selected by the Faculty Members)
 - f. One (1) Student Representative (selected by the Student Council)
 - g. One (1) Classified Representative (selected by the Classified Unit)
 - h. One (1) East High School Representative (selected by the East High School Staff).
 - i. One (1) Academy of the Redwoods Representative (selected by the Academy of the Redwoods Staff)
